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Updates from Highways

May 14<sup>th</sup>

Hall Lane (near No 27) ENQ900126278 Reported 25/1/18 We are pleased to advise that your enquiry has been updated. We have inspected and are going to resolve the problem - After investigation we have confirmed action is required. Defects are scheduled for repair depending on the nature of the defect and work needed but on average can take approximately 6 weeks.

May 21st

Hall Lane (village Hall) ENQ-201169 (W7L4T9) Highways (Follow Up/Chasing Contact: Works have been programmed to repair cracking and level out footway at this location.

Hall Lane (behind Black's Meadow) ENQ-201163 (G1R5K1) Highways FAQs (Follow Up/Chasing Contact): Works have been programmed to clear blocked gullies at this location.

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May 10<sup>th</sup>

Through my registration with Land Registry I have obtained the outline for another two properties which have boundaries alongside PROW. These are Wacton House and Wacton Hall. I have copies for Peter Jacques (Parish Councillor) as Tree Warden.

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22<sup>nd</sup> May

Wacton FP18 (Stratton Road to Haynton's Lane) Reported fingerpost in need of attention as it is lending out of position. ENQ 900134161.

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23th May

Wacton FP16 (Stratton Road to Haynton's Lane) A resident reported that the hounds from the Dunston Harriers had been along the footpath and defecated. That the staff had not cleared the faeces, either at the time or returned to do so after returning the hounds to the kennels after exercise.

It should be noted that the PROW is also the driveway to the property of the resident making the complaint and she has cleared up behind the dog no less than 5 times.

I spoke with SNDC, Community Protection Dept. who will be writing to all the contacts they have on file as to the offence. It emerged that the Dept wrote last year to the hunt for exactly the same reason. If there is failure to comply the Dept will take the matter further. I will be kept "in the loop via email".

I have kept and will keep the resident informed.
